## **The Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) of the IQAC**

**2006-2007**

### **Part A**

The plan of action chalked by IQAC for the academic year 2006 – 2007 at the end of the academic year 2005 – 2006, as detailed in our last report, towards quality enhancement, and the outcome achieved by the end of the academic year 2006 – 2007.

#### **Details of the plans of the institutions for the academic year 2006 – 2007:**

1. To begin lectures on the first working day i.e. 12.06.2006
2. To ensure 100% utilization of lecture timings.
3. To publish academic calendar by 15.06.2006.
4. To continue with centralized in-semester examinations for BMS, B.Sc. IT, B.Sc. Computer Science and B.Com. Accounting and Finance and announce the date at the beginning of the semester to inculcate a feeling of importance for in-semester examination.
5. Although the dates for completion of project work for B.Sc. Information Technology and Computer Science, B.M.S are by the end of semester i.e. 1.03.2007, students should be encouraged to complete the projects at the beginning of the semester itself which will facilitate better time management for students as well as teachers vis-a-vis teaching and learning .
6. To make greater use of teaching aids like O.H.P. and L.C.D.
7. To introduce more practical sessions, than prescribed by the university for subjects which are difficult (Specially in B.Sc. Information Technology and Computer Science)
8. To introduce more lectures than prescribed by the university for subject of Accountancy for T.Y.B.Com. students and for Financial Management for B.M.S. Fifth Semester students.

9. To inform the guardians about the first term results of their wards, who have not fared well so that more effort can be put in the second term to avoid the failure of candidates.
10. To depute as many teachers as possible for seminars or workshops for enrichment of knowledge.
11. To fulfill our long term desire of adopting a village for social work.
12. To work harder on fulfilling our social objectives
13. To conduct greater number of seminars and workshops of National and International importance on our campus.
14. To encourage more students and teachers to participate in the International Exchange Program with St. Mary's College of Business and Economics, California, U.S.A.
15. To introduce teacher wise, subject wise attendance register, with computerized data of attendance of the students for better control and teacher interaction.
16. To organize visits for the students to various research centres for advanced knowledge in the field of biotechnology.

## **Part B:**

### **1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution**

We believe in – providing quality education, creating employment opportunities, providing community service, overall personality development and respect for the environment. To achieve our organizational objectives, the various actions taken to reach our goal are enumerated in the following pages.

### **Providing Quality Education**

- We conduct guidance lectures on subjects which we feel are necessary to help the students. This year guidance lectures were conducted for:  
Business Economics  
Management and Production Planning  
Export Marketing
- In order to devote more time to class room teaching, we have asked the BMS Fifth Semester, T.Y.B.Sc. Computer Science and Information technology students to do their projects during the vacation so that the regular teaching and learning periods are not lost. This helps us to devote more time to class room teaching.
- For F.Y.B.Com and S.Y.B.Com. students test series were conducted after completion of each module in the subject of Business Economics.
- Project work was given for Managerial Economics paper to BMS second semester students in order to enrich their practical knowledge and improve their communication and presentation skills.
- The meritorious students of T.Y.B.Com. were asked to solve university question papers in the subjects of Financial Accounting, Management and Production Planning and Business Economics and they were given guidance regarding the areas where they can improve further.
- Notes highlighting important points in Management and Production Planning are prepared by teachers and given to the students at the beginning of the term so that more time can be devoted to teaching during the lecture. Copies of these notes are available in the library.
- Problems book on Financial Accounting, Management Accounting and Cost Accounting are prepared by our teachers and supplied to the students at the time of

admission. The students are required to bring it to the class room every day so that no time is wasted in dictation of problems. Copies of these notes are also available in the library.

- Students of T.Y.B.Com. and T.Y.B.Sc. Computer Science who are to appear for university examinations are specially prepared. We conduct one terminal examination before the end of the first term and the result is declared before the holidays, making it compulsory for the failed students to appear for the second terminal examinations during the holidays.
- We encouraged the bio-technology students to undertake research work in our bio-technology lab. Mr. Kunal Somani of T.Y.B.Sc.Bio-technology and Ms.Akshata of S.Y.B.Sc bio-technology produced bio-diesel in our lab.
- We sent our bio-technology students to various research centres and diagnostics for practical training.

### **Remedial Teaching**

- Fifth Semester BMS students requested for additional lectures in Logistic Management and Financial Management. We engaged two specialists Mr. Sachin Deshmukh for Logistic Management and Mr. Vishal Thabber for Financial Management for helping the students.
- Financial Management being a challenging subject for T.Y.B.M.S. fifth semester students, the number of lectures were increased to six per week against four prescribed by the University of Mumbai.
- Financial Accounting is a difficult subject for T.Y.B.Com. students so Mrs. Monali Ray increased the number of lectures from four to five per week in second term.
- Mrs. Deepika Sharma conducted group wise coaching for the subject of I.T.P. specially 'C language' for F.Y.B.Sc. IT students.
- Mrs. Deepika Sharma conducted group wise coaching for SQL language for T.Y.B.Sc. IT students.
- Mrs. Pravin Gupta was appointed as guardian teacher for Mr. Debanjan Banerji of S.Y.B.Sc. IT and due to her sincere efforts his performance improved.
- Revision lectures for Accountancy was arrange during vacation by Ms. Abida Hawaldar for T.Y.B.Com. Accounts and Finance students.

- The science background F.Y.B.M.S. students, being weak in Accountancy find it difficult to cope with finance paper in Fifth and Sixth semester. Therefore we have allocated two additional lectures of Accountancy for the science students so that the subject will be easier for them when they reach the fifth semester.

## **Creating Employment Opportunities**

- Our add on courses in computers has helped our students in the employment market.
- ‘Sambhav’ mega marketing fair in Vashi was conducted by our parent organization from 19<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> of January, 2007. The databases of the students were forwarded to various companies participating in the fair.
- Career counseling and employment bureau gives our students an opportunity for good placement in corporate organizations and invites corporates to our campus for interviews.

Eminent speakers who spoke at the seminar were Dr. A.D.Sawant, pro-vice chancellor, University of Mumbai, Dr. Shyam Kamat, Professor of International business and Economics, California state university and Director of Global programs and founding Executive Director of the Transnational Executive MBA programme.

Other speakers were Mr. Dinesh Parekh, president of Thane Belapur Industries Association, Dr. V.R Gadwal a scientist in Genetics and cytogenetics and is currently an advisor to Maharashtra Hybrid Seeds Co. Ltd and Mr. K.Venkitesh , head of Geojit Financial services.

The whole session was knowledge enriching and was attended by around 100 participants from different walks of life.

**On 13<sup>th</sup> of March 2007, Pillai's College of Arts, Commerce & Science and Pillai's Institute of Management Studies & Research hosted an international seminar on "Technological convergence and cyber security management" as a part of the sesquicentennial celebrations of the University of Mumbai.**

Our students made presentations on the basis of the case studies given to them by Harvard University and they presented a cultural program at the end of the training and received a certificate of training from St. Mary's College of California.

Dr. Roy Allen, Dean of the business school and Dr. K.M.Vasudevan Pillai, CEO of Mahatma Education Society signed the joint venture partnership wherein both institutes would host exchange students and faculty every year. Students from both institutions are

pursuing a graduate degree in their home institution, and the program complements that degree with the international experience provided to them.
