## **Part A**

A plan of action was chalked out by the IQAC in the beginning of the year towards raising the standards and enhancing the quality of the institution in terms of its functioning, infrastructure, satisfaction of stakeholders and moral responsibilities towards the society.

### **Details of the plans of the institution for the academic year 2011- 2012:**

- To begin lectures on the first working day i.e. 09.06.2011.
- To ensure 100% utilization of lecture timings.
- To prepare and publish yearly academic calendar before the beginning of the Academic year.
- To improve the facilities to student's in terms of academics, sports and co-curricular activities.
- To encourage teachers to make use of modern teaching methods like audio-visual screening, role plays, simulation, field visits and surveys.
- To make the subjects more interesting by conducting mock interviews, visits, dramas, assignments, presentations, projects amongst others.
- To provide extra coaching for subjects which are difficult by conducting sessions other than prescribed by the university.
- To keep the guardians updated about their wards performance and suggest ways to improve the same.

- To appoint guardian teachers for the weak student's.
- To help meritorious student's achieve rank at the university exams, by pursuing Advance Learners Programme.
- To identify weak student's and encourage mentoring by management, corporate guests, teachers and students.
- To recognize student grievances and promptly redress them.
- To provide infrastructure comparable to international standards.
- To improve accessibility of carefully selected print and non-print resources via library OPAC and other exceptionally responsive services.
- To encourage teachers to participate in workshops, seminars at state, national and international level.
- To strengthen the research culture.
- To bring about reforms for the effective functioning of the Examination Cell.
- To arrange special programmes for non-teaching staff.
- To continue with our social endeavors.
- To conduct greater number of seminars and workshops of National and International importance at our campus.
- To strengthen alumni participation.
- To strengthen industry linkages.

- To improve schemes for the financially backward student's.

**The IQAC took initiatives towards fulfillment of the above objectives and following are the details of the progress we made:**

- We began our lectures as per the scheduled date i.e. 09.06.2011.
- Yearly academic calendar was published towards the end of the Academic year 2010-2011.
- The Examination Calendar giving the schedules for regular, ATKT and additional exams, evaluation schedule, moderation schedule, date of result of examination for the coming academic year was published before the end of academic year 2010-2011.
- Up gradation of laboratories were ensured by procuring latest version computers for computer labs and latest technology based equipment's for biotechnology laboratories.
- The library resources were augmented with newer editions and more number of titles. Online facilities such as Inlibnet and Delnet were also updated.
- Our Research forum conducted an enriching seminar series which showed pooling of research information collected by faculty from all sister institutes.
- In aid of our academically weaker students, teachers dealing with subjects considered to be difficult were allocated with extra lectures to enable them to render extra coaching.
- Student's who find it difficult to score in examinations on account of language problem were identified and given English mentoring in the language lab.
- We continued with our teaching programmes such as Advance Learners Programme, Class Test Series, Guardian Teacher System, Student Mentoring, Tutorials etc.
- Guidance lectures were conducted for T.Y. student's of different streams.
- Invited Talks by professionals from industry and corporate world were arranged for students so as to acquaint them to practicalities of the global work scenario.

- In order to encourage guardian's participation in their wards progress, regular Parent Teacher meetings were arranged.
- Guardians were informed telephonically, if any unexpected trend was seen in their wards behaviour.
- Feed back of student's to assess their satisfaction with respect to the teaching and library facilities were taken.
- International Advanced Training Programme in Management was organized through our partnership with St. Mary's College of Business and Economics, California, U.S.A. to give international exposure to our student's.
- This year, as a part of our moral responsibility towards the society, an agenda was made with an effect that every department and association takes up a social activity each year.
- Our N.S.S Unit, Social Awareness Cell, Euridite Education Mission, Soroptomist International Association for Women and Student NGO's too worked immensely towards achieving this end.
- Nature club continued its activities aiming at sensitizing the student's towards the fast fading beauties of nature.
- Xpressions-The Celebration of Youth, the annual mega event organized by our college, was held on January, 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>, 2012 and this year saw a lot of novel innovations from the part of Student's' Council which led to success beyond expectation.
- Associations were encouraged to take their events to an inter-collegiate scale. The science exhibition conducted by the Biotechnology Association and the Management Festival conducted by the Management Association marked the beginning of this trend.
