**Part A**

**A plan of action was chalked out by the IQAC in the beginning of the year towards raising the standards and enhancing the quality of the institute in terms of its functioning, infrastructure, satisfaction of stakeholders and moral responsibilities towards the society.**

**Details of the plans of the institution for the academic year 2012-2013 was :**

- To begin lectures on the first working day i.e. 13.06.2012
- To ensure 100% utilization of lecture timings.
- To prepare and publish yearly academic calendar before the beginning of the academic year.
- To improve the facilities to students in terms of academics, sports and co-curricular activities.
- To encourage teachers to make use of modern teaching methods like audio-visual screening, role plays, simulation, field visits and surveys.

- To make the subjects more interesting by conducting mock interviews, visits, dramas, assignments, presentations, projects amongst others.
- To provide extra coaching for subjects which are difficult by conducting sessions other than prescribed by the university.
- To keep the guardians updated about their wards performance and suggest ways to improve the same.
- To provide support system for identified weak students through guardian teachers.
- To help meritorious students to perform their best at the university exams, by pursuing Advance Learners Programme.
- Mentoring by management, corporate guests, teachers and students.
- To recognize student grievances and promptly redress them.
- To provide infrastructure comparable to international standards.
- To improve accessibility of carefully selected print and non-print resources via library OPAC and other exceptionally responsive services.
- To encourage teachers to participate in workshops, seminars at state, national and international level.
- To strengthen the research culture.
- To introduce standard operating procedure for the effective functioning of the Examination Cell and office.
- To arrange special programmes for non-teaching staff.
- To continue with our social endeavors to fulfil our social obligations.
- To conduct greater number of seminars and workshops of National and International importance at our campus.
- To strengthen alumni participation.
- To strengthen industry linkages.
- To strengthen national and international linkages.
- To improve schemes for the financially backward students.
- To care for the environment by creating more awareness.

**The IQAC took initiatives towards fulfillment of the above objectives and following are the details of the progress we made:**

- We began our lectures as per the scheduled date i.e. 13.06.2012.
- Yearly academic calendar was published towards the end of the Academic year 2011-2012.
- The Examination Calendar giving the schedules for regular, A.T.K.T. and additional exams, evaluation schedule, moderation schedule, date of result of examination for the coming academic year was published before the end of academic year 2011-2012. Examination system was equipped with new systems and additional zerox facility to cater to university examination requirement as we were the centre for university examination of college situated in Navi Mumbai as centre for assessment of answer papers.
- Switching over from yearly pattern to semester pattern was successfully completed.
- Up gradation of laboratories were ensured by procuring latest version computers for computer labs and latest technology based equipment's for biotechnology laboratories.
- The library resources were augmented with newer editions and more number of titles. Online facilities were also updated.
- Our Research forum conducted an enriching seminar series which showed pooling of research information collected by faculty from all sister institutes.
- In aid of our academically weaker students, teachers dealing with subjects considered to be difficult were allocated with extra lectures to enable them to render extra coaching. Bridge courses on subjects which were not familiar to students were conducted simultaneously with lectures.
- Students who find it difficult to score in examinations on account of language problem were identified and given English mentoring in the language lab.
- We continued with our teaching programmes such as Advance Learners Programme, Class Test Series, Guardian Teacher System, Student Mentoring, Tutorials etc.
- Guidance lectures were conducted for T.Y. students of different streams through lectures by experts.
- Invited Talks by professionals from industry and corporate world were arranged for students so as to acquaint them to practicalities of the global work scenario.
- In order to encourage guardian's participation in their wards progress, regular Parent Teacher meetings were arranged.

- Guardians were informed telephonically, if any unexpected trend was seen in their wards behaviour.
- Feed back of students to assess their satisfaction with respect to the teaching and library facilities were taken.
- Certificate Courses for students were conducted in collaboration with industry/professional institutes to support the employment opportunities of the students.
- International Advanced Training Programme in Management was organized through our partnership with St. Mary's College of Business and Economics, California, U.S.A. to give international exposure to our students.
- This year, as a part of our moral responsibility towards the society, an agenda was made with an effect that every department and association takes up a social activity each year. Activities were decided and carried out in collaboration with our parent institution, Mahatma Education Society
- Our N.S.S. Unit, Social Awareness Cell, Euridite Education Mission, Soroptomist International Association for Women and Student NGO's too worked immensely towards achieving this end.
- Nature club continued its activities aiming at sensitizing the students towards the fast fading beauties of nature.
- Department of Accounting & Finance and Financial Markets organized inter-collegiate fests to encourage students to participate in extra-curricular activities. 'Empezer', inter-collegiate fest, organized by Department of Accounting and Finance on 9<sup>th</sup> February , 2013 had winter blossom as the theme. Students put in their best efforts to make this event a grand success. Various literary, art and sport events like painting, cricket, badminton, games and cultural events like dancing and singing were organized. 'Festofinanza', inter-collegiate fest, organized by Department of Financial Markets, in 6<sup>th</sup> February, 2013 had Angels & Demons as the theme. Various curricular events were organized. The hearing and speech impaired students from Rotary club of Panvel were invited and the inmates were entertained with performances by our students.
- 'ALEGRIA', inter-collegiate fest, was unique as for the first time the entire Pillai Campus (PIMSR, PIIT, PCACS, PICA, PIPT) came together and geared up for the said event as one

united youth force. More than hundred colleges participated in a number of events that spanned over five days.

- Sports Day, 'Battlefield 2012', was celebrated on 20-21<sup>st</sup> December, 2012. Students got a platform to participate in a number of events which include: Rink Football, Tug of war, Box cricket and Volleyball.
- Student's interest in research was kindled by providing them a platform to display their research potentialities. They were encouraged to participate in Avishkaar: The Research Convention organized by University of Mumbai.

### **Q.38. Development program for non-teaching staff:**
