MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 19TH DECEMBER, 2016

Agenda I

To discuss departmental activities

The Chair instructed the departments to follow the plan of action chalked out in the beginning of the year for the overall benefit of the students. It was announced that all the student support measures like Guardian teachers, bridge courses, advance learners programme, remedial coaching, mentoring, industrial visits and the like was to be continued and recorded. Also departments were directed to upgrade the departmental library and prepare reports of the department activities conducted by them.

Agenda II

To discuss student/staff welfare activities

Prof. Kavita Baddi reported that the special programs were conducted for the teaching and non-teaching staff: A session on Personal Financial Planning was conducted on 4th October, 2016 and a Movie was screened on 20th October, 2016. Recreational activities were organized for the staff and it was further shared that a 3-day Meditation Programme and a Session on 'Writing quality research papers' would be organized in the month of January, 2017.

Prof. Smitha Jayaram shared that students were supported in every way to prepare them for various inter-collegiate fests and the most sought after University Festival. She further shared that our students won several prizes in various theatre, dance and fashion show events, to name a few. She mentioned that students and staff were enthusiastically preparing for the Campus Fest, Allegria, which was scheduled from, 5th February 2017 to 11th February 2017. The Chair directed Prof. Kavita Baddi to conduct more programmes for the benefit of both teaching and non-teaching staff.

Agenda III

To discuss activities of the learning resource centre

Librarian Mr. Sanjay Munavalli shared that a Book Exhibition was organized on 12th and 13th August,2016, "Library Information Instruction Programme' was conducted for faculty members on 4th July,2016, Information Literacy Instruction Programme was organized from

16th August,2016 to 19th August, 2016 for fresher's to give instructions on how to access library resources through Koha Web-OPAC, Learning Resource Usage and the like, "Reading Motivation Day" was conducted on 15th October,2016. It was shared that the library had developed a "Mobile App" to provide real-time services to its users 24*7. Any user can download it from 'Google Play store' and keep track of their transactions. Students and faculty members could use their College I.D.No. and email provided by college to access this app. It was shared that the library staff had attended Refresher Course in Library and Information Science, had attended and organized workshops and published a number of papers in journals of repute.

The Chair directed Prof. Munavalli to procure new titles for benefit of faculty and students.

Agenda IV

To discuss career guidance/counselling activities

Prof. Shubhangi P. and Prof. Jennie Prajith shared that our alumni placed in different companies addressed counselling sessions organized for students. Companies like Hexaware Ltd., L&T, Wipro, Barclay's Pvt. Ltd., Edu sharp Pvt. Ltd. and the like have conducted seminars and workshops in the campus for the benefit of students. It was shared that career counselling seminars had been planned with many organizations of repute to name a few: Thomas Cook, Navi Mumbai Chapter of the Institute of Cost Accountants of India and the like. The Chair directed them to conduct more of such sessions in future for the benefit of the student community.

Agenda V

To discuss social/extension activities

Prof. Kiran Deshmukh shared that Community Service Day will be celebrated on 21st January, 2017. She further added that the following NGOs would be hosted on that day: Ramakrishna Niketan and Rajeev Rajan Aadharghar, Shantivan, Nere. She shared that railway safety week in association with railway police force was celebrated from 28th November 2016-1st December 2016. Orphanages, Zilla Parished school, School for Deaf & Dumb and other NGOs were visited by departments wherein donations were made in cash and kind, sessions on personal hygiene and environmental cleanliness were arranged, cultural events etc. were also organized.Prof. Ruchika Bassi shared that in the said academic year, 68 students from different streams enrolled themselves in different activities like SWS, APY, IOP and CP of Life Long Learning. It was further shared that all the extension work students had started their projects which would be submitted by 31st January, 2017.

Dr. Aarti Sukheja shared that faculty must involve students in social work as this would

enhance social sensitivity in them.

Agenda VI

To discuss research based activities and consultancy

Dr. Rinkoo Shantnu shared that faculty was motivated to send various research proposals for

funding and mentioned that teachers were guided for the same. Dr. Seema Somani shared that

12 students participated in the Avishkar Research Convention out of which two qualified for

university level and one for state level. She added that a Workshop for giving hands on

training on statistical methods for aiding research would be conducted in the month of

February, 2017. The Chair announced that projects of high quality would receive funding from

the management incase they fail to get grants from other sources.

Agenda VII

To discuss linkages

With regards to our joint initiative with New York University (NYU), Stern School of

Business known as the Urban Expansion Observatory (UXO), which consists of measuring

the quality of global urban expansion through the analysis of high-resolution

satellite imagery, such as that available in Google Earth, Dr. Smitha Jayaram shared that

students were given an opportunity of working as interns with various job profiles like data

collection & creating a database, developing an android app. and the like. She further added

that the student interns were being paid well at par with the market and also had the

opportunity to sharpen their skills. The Chair directed the staff to motivate to students to take

benefit from this linakge. The Chair announced that in the near future further linkages would

be given due consideration for the benefit of the teaching and learning community.
