The National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of Pillai college of Arts, Commerce and Science had organised a leprosy education, rehabilitation and treatment campaign jointly with NGO, ALERT-INDIA, on 28th July, 2017. The objective of the event was to focus on the causes of leprosy, signs and symptoms and to overcome it by simple and effective treatment. DEPARTMENT OF MASS MEDIA





