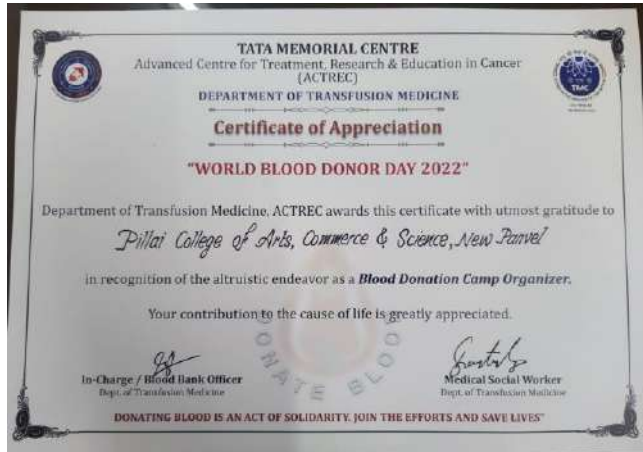




## Felicitatation for Blood Donation

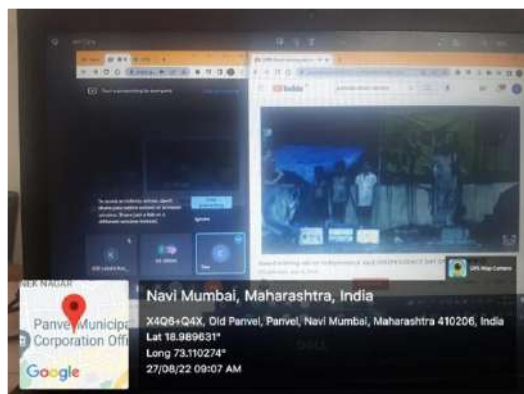

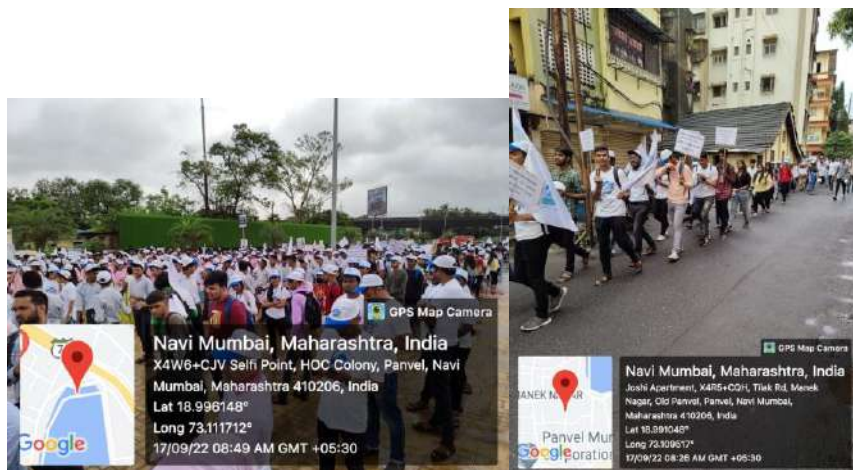




## Indian Swachhata League

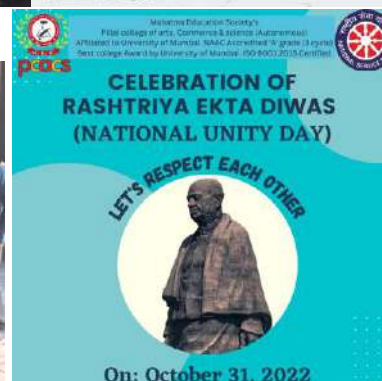


### Rashtriya Ekta Diwas

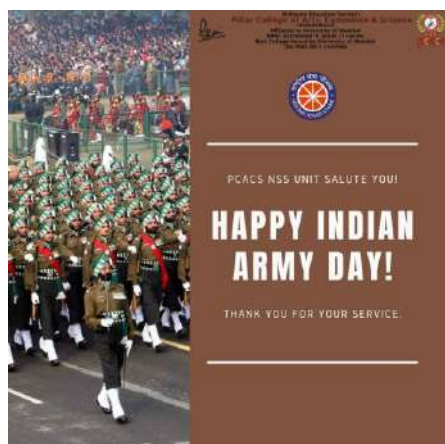
